

(X)--SPACING INFORMATION CAN BE FOUND IN THE APPROPRIATE EPG ARTICLE. THE SPACING SHOULD BE SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW THE AVERAGE MOTORIST TIME TO DECELERATE TO THE POSTED SPEED.

- \*SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 200 FEET FROM SPEED LIMIT SIGN IF A DISTANCE SIGN IS NOT PRESENT.
- \*\*THIS SIGN SHOULD BE LOCATED 2 FEET TO THE RIGHT OF THE CITY LIMIT SIGN. THE BOTTOM OF THIS SIGN SHOULD BE AT THE SAME HEIGHT AS THE CITY LIMIT SIGN.
- IF ADDITIONAL SIGNS ARE REQUIRED, SPACING BETWEEN SIGNS SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 200 FEET.

MISCELLANEOUS REGULATORY SIGNS SHOULD NOT BE ERECTED IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE CITY LIMITS.
