

(X)--SPACING INFORMATION CAN BE FOUND IN TABLE 11-2 IN SIGN MANUAL, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 11.1.2. THE SPACING SHOULD BE SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW THE AVERAGE MOTORIST TIME TO DECELERATE TO THE POSTED SPEED.

\*SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 200 FEET FROM SPEED LIMIT SIGN IF A DISTANCE SIGN IS NOT PRESENT.

\*\*THIS SIGN SHOULD BE LOCATED 2 FEET TO THE RIGHT OF THE CITY LIMIT SIGN. THE BOTTOM OF THIS SIGN SHOULD BE AT THE SAME HEIGHT AS THE CITY LIMIT SIGN.

IF ADDITIONAL SIGNS ARE REQUIRED. SPACING BETWEEN SIGNS SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 200 FEET.

MISCELLANEOUS REGULATORY SIGNS SHOULD NOT BE ERECTED IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE CITY LIMITS.
